Regulation (EU) No. 1907/2006 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), Annex XVII

Since June 1, 2007, the new EU regulation (REACH (Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals), a European chemical legislation, has been in effect, which has replaced some areas of the previous applicable directives and regulations.

REACH requires registration of all chemical substances used in the EU as such as well as substances in preparations and articles. This regulation covers all chemical substances, regardless of whether they have dangerous properties or not. Substance registration must be carried out by manufacturers and importers at the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) in Helsinki.

The products of h+s Präzisionsfolien GmbH are products (non-chemical products) within the meaning of the REACH regulation and are not subject to any registration, evaluation or approval obligation, since, as far as we know, no chemicals are released under normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions. The quantity threshold of 1000kg per year is not exceeded (downstream user), (see website:

All products from h+s Präzisionsfolien GmbH are manufactured in accordance with the regulations applicable to them, including REACH (Appendix XVII).

All products and packaging materials from h+s Präzisionsfolien GmbH currently do not contain any substances from the SVHC list.

According to Article 33 of the REACH Regulation, manufacturers of articles have an obligation to provide information if an article contains a substance of concern (SVHC) in a concentration of more than 0.10% by mass. SVHC are substances that meet the criteria of Article 57. A current SVHC candidate list is published regularly by the European Chemicals Agency ECHA and is available on its homepage at <https://echa.europa.eu/de/candidate-list-table> .
