General customer information on packaging in Germany

h+s Präzisionsfolien GmbH and Schwab GmbH&Co. KG

The law on the placing on the market, taking back and high-quality recycling of packaging (VerpackG) defines the requirements for product responsibility for packaging. It contains

the general objective of preventing or reducing the impact of packaging waste on the

environment.

Disposal of packaging

In accordance with § 15 Paragraph 1 Clause 5 VerpackG, we would like to point out that

we can take back the transport packaging of our products on request in accordance with

the provisions of § 15 Paragraph 1 VerpackG.

By returning the item, you help ensure that undamaged packaging can be used again. If

possible, damaged packaging is fed into the material cycle or disposed of professionally.

However, you are not obliged to return the transport packaging to us.

We recommend handing over the cardboard product and transport packaging directly to a

disposal company. In this way, we jointly avoid additional transport, effort and emissions. In

addition, we contribute to environmental protection through resource-saving waste

management.

Licensing of packaging

h+s Präzisionsfolien GmbH and Schwab GmbH&Co. KG does not ship packaging that is

subject to system participation according to § 3 (8) VerpackG, since we only deliver to

commercial customers (B2B) and the end customers of our products are typically not

private consumers or comparable sources according to § 3 (11) VerpackG.

Therefore, there is no obligation to license our sales packaging via a dual system

according to § 7 VerpackG.

Substance Restrictions

The placing on the market of packaging or packaging components in which the cumulative

concentration of lead, cadmium, mercury and chromium VI exceeds the value of 100

milligrams per kilogram is prohibited.

All products from h+s Präzisionsfolien GmbH and Schwab GmbH&Co. KG are developed

and manufactured in accordance with the applicable regulations.

To the best of our knowledge, the packaging we deliver to you does not contain any

substances whose placing on the market is prohibited in accordance with the Packaging

Directive (94/62/EC) (Article 11) or the law on the placing on the market, the return and the

high-quality recycling of packaging (§ 5) (Packaging Act).
